

Loveland Housing Authority is looking for a resourceful and process oriented Accounting Supervisor to manage the multiple entities and funds within the Authority. The Accounting Supervisor is also responsible for supervising, managing workloads, and providing technical assistance to a staff of six non-exempt and non-supervisory exempt employees.

This is a full-time regular position with benefits, with a hiring range of \$80,000 to \$100,000 per year depending upon experience. In addition, this position is offered a benefits package which includes health, vision, dental, life insurance, short- and long-term disability plans, a cafeteria plan, paid time off, paid holidays, a 457(b)-retirement plan with employer match, and an employee assistance program. Loveland Housing Authority also promotes employee development along with a healthy work life balance.

Qualified candidates are required to have a Bachelor's degree in Finance, Accounting, or related field. A Master's degree is preferred. Also, must have a minimum of five (5) years of progressive experience relevant to the essential job functions along with three (3) years of supervisory experience. An equivalent combination of education and/or experience may substitute for the education requirement on a year-for-year basis. Public sector experience is highly preferred.
