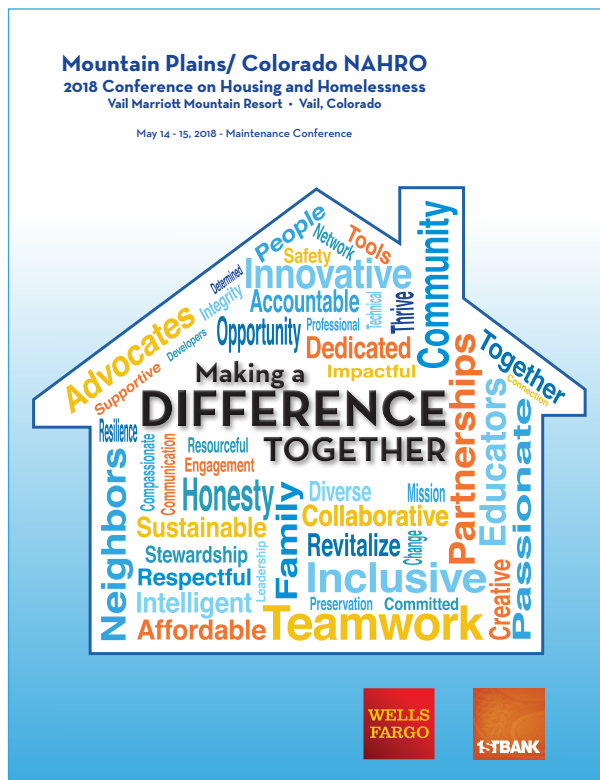


Colorado NAHRO Maintenance Conference

Workshops

MONDAY, MAY 14

Interior Repairs and ADA Asset Protection - Salons B/C/D, 9:00 - 11:45

This class will teach basic drywall repair and texture matching as well as methodologies for prepping a unit for current ADA use. This class will be taught by Sherwin-Williams, Certa Pro Painters and CleanCut Bath.

Basic Boiler Operation - Salons I/H/G, 9:00 - 11:45

Learn the basics of hot water heating, terminology, mechanics and controls.

Basic Air Conditioning - Blue Sky Room, 9:00 - 11:45

The workshop covers information necessary to safely perform routine repairs, testing and troubleshooting on air conditioning equipment.

GE Refrigeration & Repairs - Salons B/C/D, 1:15 - 4:30

Representatives for GE will present an in depth look at the operation, troubleshooting and repair of a 18 cubic foot refrigerator.

Hands On Electrical - Salons I/H/G, 1:15 - 4:30

Learn the basics of electricity and electrical wiring systems through a combination of demonstrations and hands-on practice.

Biohazards in the Workplace - Blue Sky Room, 1:15 - 2:45

Have you ever wondered exactly what are the dangers you face in dealing with death or trauma scenes you are called to? What are the other biohazards in your work environment and how can you protect yourself?

REAC Inspections 1 - Blue Sky Room, 3:00 - 4:30

Let's talk REAC! Come talk openly about what works and what doesn't. Hear from experienced personnel who have worked with REAC and its inspectors for years. Share your experiences in an open forum setting with maintenance technicians from all over the region.

TUESDAY, MAY 15

Bed Bugs and Integrated Pest Management - Salons B/C/D, 8:45 - 11:45

Let's talk about pests – cockroaches, mice, bed bugs and more. This session will look at pest management through an integrated approach. Integrated Pest Management (IPM) uses pest biology, environmental information and chemical and non-chemical tools to manage pests. IPM programs focus on preventive measures—getting at the root of the problem before an infestation occurs.

Heating: Gas and Electric - Salons I/H/G, 8:30 - 11:45

Learn the how's and why's of heating systems including electric and gas controls and how they work on air handler type systems. Controls on other types of systems can be discussed at the student's request.

Plumbing Service -

Blue Sky Room, 8:30 - 11:45

This is an excellent introductory course on plumbing including basic functions, the installation of fixtures, drain cleaning, troubleshooting, repair, safety and more.

Mold: Identify, Prevent, Remediate - Salons B/C/D, 1:15 - 2:45

This session will focus on the hazards you may come in contact with when performing repairs, maintenance and renovation.

Tree Maintenance: From Pruning to Preventative Maintenance -

Salons I/H/G, 1:15 - 2:45

A certified Arborist will be teaching best practices for maintaining the trees on your properties. From pruning to preventative maintenance. He will also be talking about the Emerald Ash Borer Disease and how to fight it.

Safety on Site for Maintenance Techs -

Blue Sky Room, 1:15 - 2:45

Safety is the highest priority of maintenance professionals. This session is an excellent introduction to OSHA and the regulations they have designed to keep the maintenance associate healthy. Common sense applications and ideas will also be discussed.

Hash Oil Production and Meth Education - Salons B/C/D, 3:00 - 4:30

This session will explore how hash oil is made and the inherent dangers in producing hash oil. We will also examine how to detect hash oil production. A presentation on how to detect meth by identifying by products and clean up techniques in units where meth has been used.

REAC: Ins and Outs – Salons I/H/G, 3:00 – 4:30

A description of the REAC process, scoring model, appeals, and new updates will be discussed in this session.

Sustainability – Energy Minded Operations and Maintenance – Blue Sky Room, 3:00 – 4:30 **SPONSORED BY WESTERN DISPOSAL**

This session will cover the basics of water and energy conservation as they relate to Operations and Maintenance (O&M) and how to best integrate these into existing O&M policies. New energy efficient technologies will also be covered. Recommended for grounds personnel and maintenance supervisors.
